

# PONYBANGS INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

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## **Tools**

- rubber band

Your horse needs to have enough natural forelock to hold the weight of the Pony Bangs. When installing Pony Bangs ensure that the hair on the Pony Bangs is laying upwards towards the ears. There are two installation recommendations.

You can horizontally finger part your horse's natural forelock and pull the top section of hair through the Pony Bangs opening. Now rubber band the two sections of natural forelock together with the cord running in between. Then pull the cord lock to tighten the Pony Bangs. Cover the Pony Bangs mechanism and natural forelocks by flipping the Pony Bang hair down.

You can pull the full forelock through the Pony Bangs opening and pull on the elastic cord to tighten, then rubber band the elastic cord together with the natural forelocks to secure Pony Bangs. Cover the Pony Bangs mechanism and natural forelocks by flipping the Pony Bang hair down.

For removal: Lift up the hair piece to reveal the mechanism and safely remove the rubber band. Because I did not have a seam Easy Peasy!
